As the pandemic rages on, we are witnessing innumerable problems cropping up that need immediate attention. However, one constant need that is being overlooked in the medical-need crisis is that of hunger. As Covid spreads like wildfire to the rural pockets of India, availability of ration and vegetables; the need for isolation centers; means of livelihood generation during the lockdown; and urgent medical care; all put together have become issues that need immediate addressal. With the ever-growing needs, we have scaled up our interventions with our grassroots networks and are delivering these essential services.

Through our functioning processing centers, we are curating individual **Food Kits**, reaching them even to the remotest parts across the country, and **Medical Interventions**, focusing on the last-mile health workers and individuals who require it; we are procuring and channelizing **Medical Aid**; at our various production units, we are making **Face Masks** on a large scale. We are also building partnerships to convert unused buildings such as schools, into **Not Alone Centres**; and supporting **Khichri Dhabas** (Roadside Eateries) with rations to ensure food security. We are continually scaling up our interventions and in this race with time, we need your support to stand with our fellow citizens.

MEDICAL INTERVENTION





Filling crucial gaps

Key gaps are being filled through medical interventions for immediate effect. We are reaching out with medical aids to address aspects of early recognition, initial diagnosis, preventative and basic medical care for all. Medical aid such as comprehensive kits of generic medicines, masks, gloves, thermometers, oximeters, ORS, PPE Kits, sanitizers and other essentials are being reached as per need to frontline workers and more concise kits are being reached to individuals. Work on oxygen cylinders and concentrators are also in progress.



Not Alone Centres

With many families living in small spaces, lack of personal space for millions is a common issue. Thus, to address the very important need of physical distancing, we have lent our support in creating Not Alone Centres in existing buildings by providing necessary equipment. They are already up and running in Maharashtra and West Bengal.







ENSURING FOOD SECURITY







Food Kits

Communities across India are having a tough time surviving the second wave due to lack of food and zero resources. Goonj is working actively and has channelized ration and other essentials to the remotest parts across the country.





Khichri Dhabas

To stand with the people during this pandemic, We are supporting community kitchens, which serve daily meals. At present, we have also begun 'Khichri Dhabas' (roadside eateries) in few states, and have more in the process of being set-up. The dhabas are where people can come and have meals free of cost, or at minimal cost. This is to support the Dhabas by reviving and running them to ensure food security.









Working with Farmers

Nutritious food is extremely important to be able to stay healthy, especially with the pandemic now reaching one and all. Rural communities too, are at high risk for contracting the disease. Moreover, usually most of them have no access to basic vegetables or fruits, thus always lacking nutrition. Also, due to the lockdown, the farmers have no place to sell their produce. Thus, in order to address both these situations, we are procuring vegetables/fruits directly from the farmers and reaching them to the nearby villages/areas, ensuring nutrition for the local residents.





FOCUS ON MISSED-OUT COMMUNITIES





With no access to the basics, they are in an unspeakable state. Goonj's relief efforts across states are on in full swing for such communities. Be it providing nutritional support to vulnerable tribal groups, to first-aid or medical support to the leprosy-affected. So far 5,400 leprosy affected families are supported in a few colonies. India has about 800 such colonies.



We are extending our support in terms of livelihood generation by working with them on various initiatives. Additionally, transportation to vaccination centres, reimbursement for oxygen cylinders and oxygen refills, and material support for community kitchens, daily essentials, ration and medical requirements are also being reached to them.
