- Dry ration like rice, pulses, spices, sugar, tea leaves, milk powder, cooking oil (sealed packs), biscuits, snacks, and ready-to-eat food
- General medicines, toiletries, sanitary pads, chlorine tablets, bleaching powder
- Tarpaulins, blankets, mosquito nets
- Wearable clothing (all age groups), new undergarments, slippers
- Cooking Utensils, umbrellas, raincoats
- Torches, batteries, solar lights
- School materials and toys
